

When I was growing up my civics teacher told me that the reason the FCC existed was because there was a limited supply of over-the-air bandwidth. In particular, that is why there was no FCC jurisdiction over telephones - there is no limit to the bandwidth available over wires, because you can always string more wires. This has not changed. There is no legitimate rationale for any form of FCC involvement in the wired (or fiber) Internet. If any government agency has jurisdiction over ISPs, it would be the FTC on monopoly grounds (not that FTC regulation would be good, either.) Your agency is taking actions under color of law that have no legal basis. Someone should go to jail about it.
