County Level Accuracy Order

Carriers are currently required to meet accuracy requirements at a nationwide level using either a network based solution (100/300m) or a handset based solution (50/150m) at the 67th percentile and 95th percentile

Updated Accuracy Order is based on a proposal from AT&T, NENA, and APCO that would require carriers meet existing accuracy requirements at the County Level at the 67th percentile and 90th percentile

County Level benchmarks

67th Percentile (100m) Accuracy

End of Year 1: Carriers shall comply in 60% of counties, which counties shall cover at least 70% of the POPs covered by the carrier, network-wide.

End of Year 3: Carriers shall comply in 70% of counties, which counties shall cover at least 80% of the POPs covered by the carrier, network-wide.

End of Year 5: Carriers shall comply in 100% of counties.

90th Percentile (300m) Accuracy

End of Year 3: Carriers shall comply in 60% of counties, which counties shall cover at least 70% of the POPs covered by the carrier, network-wide.

End of Year 5: Carriers shall comply in 70% of counties, which counties shall cover at least 80% of the POPs covered by the carrier, network-wide.

End of Year 8: Carriers shall comply in 85% of counties.

Carriers may elect to use a 1) network based accuracy data; 2) blended accuracy data (network/handset); 3) handset accuracy data (subject to the handset accuracy numbers) provided they meet a specific penetration rate or offer of free handset within the county
