Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Charles McKee and I of Sprint Nextel Corp. met with Angela Kronenberg of Commissioner Clyburn's office to discuss traffic pumping. Sprint provided an update on its traffic pumping disputes, and urged the Commission to act expeditiously to put a halt to traffic pumping activity. Sprint recommended that the Commission adopt a cap on average usage per line per month, above which the LEC may assess only cost-based, just and reasonable rates; and declare that revenue sharing is an unlawful practice and that LECs may not assess either access charges or reciprocal compensation rates on traffic subject to revenue sharing arrangements.
