Pursuant to Section 1.1200, et seq., of the Commission's Rules, National Public Radio, Inc. ("NPR") hereby notifies the Commission of the following *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding.

On Thursday, September 9, 2010, Mike Starling, NPR Vice President and Chief Technology Officer and Executive Director of NPR Labs, and John Kean, NPR Senior Technologist, met with Ann Gallagher, Norman Miller, and Susan Crawford, all of the Media Bureau. The parties discussed testing currently being conducted by NPR Labs, including testing of HD Radio asymmetrical sideband transmission for compatibility with analog FM reception. NPR also demonstrated equipment in use for a live field trial of HD Radio conditional access, which is being evaluated for use by stations to disseminate radio reading services to the visually impaired.
