On September 10, 2010, Michael Skrivan, Vice President of Regulatory for FairPoint Communications, Inc. met via telephone conference with Commission staff Daniel Ball and Lisa Gelb and Separations Joint Board state staff members Lori Kenyon from Alaska, Joel Shifman from Maine, Elaine Weist from South Dakota, Sandy Reams from Kansas, and George Young from Vermont to discuss jurisdictional allocation matters in the above-referenced docket. Mr. Skrivan responded to questions raised by these federal and state representatives on interim jurisdictional separations reform. Mr. Skrivan also identified company concerns that jurisdictional shifts could have on revenue and advocated that the Commission maintain the current jurisdictional allocations.
