On September 14, Melissa Newman met with Christi Shewman and Brad Gillen, Legal Advisors to Commissioner Meredith Baker. On September 15, Melissa Newman met with Angela Kronenberg, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn.

In the meetings, Qwest urged the FCC to issue orders on phantom traffic, traffic pumping and VOIP classification. These issues have been fully developed in the record and it is important for the FCC to take concrete steps now to reduce arbitrage opportunities.
