
On September 17, 2010, Christin McMeley and Crystal Dollins of Charter Communications, Paul Glist of the law firm of Davis Wright Tremaine LLP, and Sam Feder of the law firm of Jenner & Block LLP had separate meetings with Josh Cinelli, Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps, Eloise Gore, Acting Media Legal Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn, Rosemary Harold, Legal Advisor to Commissioner McDowell and Brad Gillen, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Baker.

They expressed support for a rule allowing HD DTAs, which will be critical for Charter to deploy more digital services with minimum disruption to consumers.

They also expressed the view that as broadcast retransmission consent fees increase, the Commission will need to exercise greater supervision, and adopt remedial protections (such a temporary timing relief so a broadcaster can no longer threaten to pull a signal immediately before a key event).
