Verizon California Inc., Verizon Florida LLC, GTE Southwest Inc. (d/b/a Verizon Southwest), Verizon South Inc. and Verizon North Retain Co. ("Verizon") submit the enclosed three applications for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act and 47 C.F.R § 63.71 to discontinue the following services: (1) Metallic Services; (2) Special Access High Capacity DS1C and DS3 services; and (3) Special Access Wideband Data services and Special Access Wideband Analog services which are offered today under Verizon's FCC Tariff Nos. 14 or 16. As indicated in the attached applications, Verizon will discontinue these services in the impacted areas on or after December 2, 2010. 2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

Subject to Commission authorization under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71 Verizon will discontinue Special Access Wideband Data services and Special Access Wideband Analog services in the impacted areas on or after December 2, 2010.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

Subject to Commission authorization under 47 C.F.R. § 63.71 Verizon will discontinue Special Access Wideband Data services in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following Contel areas: California, Texas, Pennsylvania, Virginia and North Carolina. Verizon will also discontinue Special Access Wideband Analog services

in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following former GTE areas: California, Florida, Texas, Pennsylvania and Virginia; and in Verizon's remaining service territory in the following the former Contel areas: California, Texas, Pennsylvania, Virginia and North Carolina.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(4), b(2)):

Verizon's Special Access Wideband Data services provide dedicated facilities between customer designated premises or between a customer designated premises and a Telephone Company hub for the transmission of synchronous serial data at the rate of 18.75 kbps, 19.2 kbps, 40.8 kbps, 50.0 kbps or 230.4 kbps or asynchronous serial data at rates of up to 19.2 kbps, 50.0 kbps, or 230.4 kbps.

Verizon's Special Access Wideband Analog services provide a circuit between two customer designated premises or locations or between a customer designated premise or location and a Telephone Company hub. Verizon's Special Access Wideband Analog services provide for the transmission of wideband signals at bandwidths from 60 to 108 kHz (Group), 312 to 552 kHz (Supergroup), 564 to 3084 kHz (Mastergroup), 300 Hz to 18 kHz, 29 kHz to 44 kHz, or 28 kHz to 44 kHz.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the proposed service discontinuations. Currently, there are no customers for these services in the impacted areas. In addition, suppliers have discontinued manufacturing the equipment required to provision the services being discontinued and as a result parts for these services are no longer readily available. Finally, Verizon and other providers offer alternatives to the services being discontinued. For Special Access Wideband Data services, the

alternatives include Special Access Voice Grade, Digital Data, and Special Access High Capacity (DS1 and DS3 services). For Special Access Wideband Analog services, the alternatives include Special Access High Capacity DS3 service.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (b)(3)):

In the impacted areas, there currently are no customers for the services being discontinued. Accordingly, there are no customers to notify about the proposed discontinuance.

Copies of this Application are being sent via first class U.S. Mail to the governors and public utilities commissions of each impacted state, and the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

Verizon is considered dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

CONCLUSION

Verizon respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Application.
