Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, September 29, 2010, Pete Tridish of Prometheus Radio Project (“Prometheus”) and Matt Wood, counsel to Prometheus, spoke briefly by telephone with Eloise Gore, Acting Media Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, to discuss matters in the above-captioned docket.

During the telephone conference, the Prometheus representatives advocated that Commissioner Clyburn consider – in connection with the item currently on circulation in this docket – the revised version of the Memorandum of Agreement Regarding LPFM/FM Translator Priorities jointly filed on September 22, 2010, by Prometheus and Educational Media Foundation. They also referred briefly to the study on this topic prepared by advocacy organization Common Frequency, and likewise filed in the docket under separate cover on September 28, 2010. Consistent with the statements in these earlier filings, the Prometheus representatives are concerned about the likely efficacy and effect of the ten application cap proposed for translators in the Commission’s Third Report and Order & Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in this docket.
