

WRC-12 ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Meeting Minutes

Meeting: IWG-4, 17th Meeting

Date/Time: June 2, 2010, 2 p.m.

Location: FCC, Conference Room TW-C438/468

Meeting Summary: The meeting convened at 2 p.m. with Jose Albuquerque in the chair. The agenda (Doc. IWG-4/.067) was approved with the addition of the Draft Preliminary View from SkyTerra (Doc. IWG-4/.063). The minutes of the prior meeting were approved (Doc. IWG/4-066r3). Brennan Price (ARRL) volunteered to draft the minutes of this meeting.

The meeting discussed the status of WRC preparations and recent related activities. Jonathan Williams (NTIA) described the status of contributions to Working Party 1B. Don Jansky reported on discussions within Working Party 4A regarding Agenda Items 7 and 8, as well as Resolution 80.

Kim Baum reported that she had received comments from Jack Wengryniuk on Document IWG-4/57, which had been approved last meeting. The suggested edits were minor. They will be considered approved if no objection by the next meeting.

The group considered the following contributions:

- Document IWG-4/059, an NTIA draft proposal on Agenda Item 1.6, came before IWG-4 for the third time. In the absence of objection, the IWG concurred with the proposal.
- Draft Preliminary View on Agenda Item 1.2 (Doc. IWG-4/063, formerly IWG-4/31r1)—Damon Ladson indicated that no changes had been made since the last meeting. SkyTerra would still like the document to be considered as a United States view. Kim Baum and Jose Albuquerque suggested that concerns they expressed at the last meeting continued to apply. The document was tabled.

Draft Proposal on Agenda Item 1.2 (Doc. IWG-4/065)—Kim Baum and Giselle Creeser introduced the document, noting various suggestions made by parties. Damon Ladson indicated some reservations. The document is a work in progress, and was tabled.

Draft Proposal on Agenda Item 7 (Integrated MSS Systems) (Doc. IWG-4/028r5) –Tom Tycz indicated at length some changes he had made, and noted a disagreement as to whether RR 4.4

needed to be addressed. Jack Wengryniuk suggested comments in resolves 2. The document was tabled for further consideration at a later meeting.

Draft Proposal on Agenda Item 8.2 (Integrated MSS Systems) (Doc. IWG-4/062)—This document proposes to address CGC issue head-on at WRC-12. Inmarsat reiterates opposition to co-primary CGC status, and suggests national or regional approach is best. Chair asked if there was a possibility of consensus on this matter. Damon Ladson indicated that in his view, the advice given by the WAC need not indicate consensus, and that this might be the most realistic way forward. The document was tabled.

Draft Proposal on Agenda Item 4 (Rec. 206) (Doc. IWG-4/064)—Damon Ladson proposed to modify resolution with respect to L band. The chair suggested we are in a similar situation as to the previous document. The chair suggested moving forward with two different views; in the interim, the document was tabled.

Draft Proposal on Agenda Item 7 (Reduction of Coordination Arc) (Doc. IWG-4/58)—This document was tabled pending incorporation of material generated by Working Party 4A.

The template for Agenda Item 4 (IWG-4/032) was not discussed.

The next meeting was set for July 21, 2010.

There was no other business.

Public Participation Statement: This meeting was open to the public, and 34 persons participated.
