

As a resident of Delaware since 1957, I'd like to commend the Commission for adding a VHF assignment to Seaford, DE, the first commercial VHF assignment since WVUE-TV, Wilmington, went off the air in 1958.

However, regarding the auction proceeding, I note that channel 4 has been added to Atlantic City, NJ, which is in the Philadelphia, PA market DMA. Since Seaford, DE has a population of roughly 10,000 people and is in the Salisbury market (DMA > 150). It seems reasonable that the opening bid for Seaford, DE should be less than a station in the Philadelphia market. Therefore, I propose that the Seaford, DE opening bid should be \$50,000, and the Atlantic City, NJ bid be kept at \$200,000.
