On October 4, 2010, Jeanine Poltronieri, Michael Goggin and Gary Phillips of AT&T, and David Lawson of Sidley, Austin, LLP, representing AT&T, met with FCC staff to discuss the above captioned proceeding. Representing the FCC at the meeting were FCC General Counsel Austin Schlick, Julie Veach, Andrea Kearney, Chris Killion, and David Horowitz of the Office of General Counsel as well as Paul Murray, Nese Guendelsberger, Peter Trachtenberg, Jennifer Salhus and Christina Clearwater of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Ms. Clearwater participated via teleconference. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss AT&T's opposition to a mandatory data roaming requirement, consistent with AT&T's comments filed in this proceeding. AT&T summarized its position, as represented in its filings, that data roaming is a Private Mobile Service, as defined in Section 332 of the Telecommunications Act and thus any common carrier regulation of data roaming is prohibited under the terms of the statute.
