The purpose of the meeting was to ask that the FCC move forward in adopting a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in accordance with the Petition filed by UTC and Winchester in the above-captioned proceeding. We discussed the need for additional spectrum in the 14.0-14.5 GHz band for smart grid applications and for more robust communications by critical infrastructure industry ("CII") entities in times of disasters and other emergencies. We also discussed the importance of making available spectrum in the 14 GHz band to be used on a preemptible basis for backhaul services, a critical element in continued deployment of broadband services to all Americans.
