On October 14, 2010, Mark Stachiw, Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Secretary of MetroPCS Communications, Inc. (“MetroPCS”), along with Carl W. Northrop and Michael Lazarus of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker LLP (“Paul Hastings”), met with Julius Knapp, Geraldine Matise and Walter Johnston of the Office of Engineering and Technology.

During this conference the participants discussed MetroPCS’ recently-launched, first U.S. commercial 4G Long Term Evolution (“LTE”) networks, and MetroPCS’ offering of the world’s first commercially-available 4G LTE handset, the Samsung Craft. MetroPCS had with it a Samsung Craft handset for the participants to see, and discussed its 4G LTE network deployments in Las Vegas, NV and in the Dallas-Fort Worth, TX Metroplex. MetroPCS also discussed its plans to continue its 4G LTE network buildout through the end of 2010 and throughout 2011.

MetroPCS also discussed the status of the NTIA spectrum report and related FCC spectrum proceedings.
