Dear Ms. Dortch:

With reference to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, 47 USC §214(a), Progress International, LLC ("Transferee") hereby requests a 60-day extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") that is due to expire October 25, 2010 to allow Epana Networks, Inc. ("Epana" or the "Company") to continue to provide interstate telecommunications services pending action on an application for permanent Section 214 authority for the transfer of control of Epana from Sienna Limited Partnership III, LP and other stockholders to Transferee. The application is under consideration in WC Docket No. 10-163.

On August 26, 2010, both the Wireline Competition Bureau and International Bureau granted STA in this matter for a 60-day period that expires October 25, 2010. An extension of STA is needed to allow additional time for "Team Telecom" to complete its review of information provided by the applicants and provide input to the Commission concerning the subject transaction. Joanne P. Ongman, Attorney, Foreign Investment Review Staff, National Security Division, U.S. Department of Justice, has authorized the undersigned to state that Team Telecom has no objection to extension of STA for a 60-day period.

Extension of STA will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity because it will permit the continued provision of service by Epana without interruption to customers while the Commission considers the application for approval of the transfer of control.

Transferee acknowledges that extension of STA will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the underlying application for Commission consent to the transfer of control of Epana. Transferee further acknowledges that STA may be revoked by the Commission upon its own motion without a hearing.
