Dear Sir/Ma'am:

Lane College ("Lane") is the licensee of EBS channel(s) G1, G2, G3, and G4 under FCC call sign WLX817. The geographic service area reference point for this authorization is located in the Jackson, TN BTA - BTA Number 211.

Pursuant to Section 21.1236 of the Commission's Rules, April 21, 2009 was the deadline for filing the subject Self Transition Notification. To the extent necessary, since the reason for this late filing was due to the pending consideration of our Petition for Reconsideration resulting in the renewal of the license, we hereby request a waiver of Section 21.1236 of the Commission's Rules. Because of the pending petition for reconsideration which resulted in the renewal of the license, good cause exists for waiver of the April 21, 2009 deadline, and the acceptance of this late-filed Self Transition Notification.

A Self-Transition Notification will be sent to the other licensees in the Jackson TN BTA and to those licensees whose GSA boundaries overlap the boundary associated with station WLX817. (In the interest in saving resources, all notifications will be sent via email wherever possible.) This Notification will include the information specified in Section 27.1236(c). Any potential interference conflicts revealed during the channel transition process will be coordinated with the licensees where interference exists; however, no interference is expected since the Lane license is not currently constructed.

At this time, ESD's license is unconstructed, and the current plan is to have it constructed with substantial service on or prior to May 1, 2011. The modification application to the "New Band Plan" has already been filed and approved by the Commission; it was filed on August 19, 2010.
