Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1200, et seq., Harris Corporation (“Harris”) provided members of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) with an ex parte presentation in the above-referenced proceedings. On October 20, 2010, on behalf of Harris, Carl Bradley (Sales Engineer, Cyber Integrated Solutions), Deborah Brown (Director of Client Advocacy, Cyber Integrated Solutions), and Evan Morris (Legal Analyst, Government Relations) met with Jeffery Goldthorp, Ahmed Lahjouji, and Gary Thayer of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau.
