Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 25, 2010, Kathryn A. Zachem, Vice President, Regulatory and State Legislative Affairs, Comcast Corporation, Rick Cotton, Executive Vice President and General Counsel, NBC Universal, Inc. (by telephone), and the undersigned, Counsel for Comcast Corporation, (collectively, "Applicants") met with the following Commission personnel regarding the above-captioned proceeding: John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman on Transactions, Rick Kaplan, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to the Chairman, William Freedman, Associate Chief, Media Bureau, and Jennifer Tatel, Chief, Industry Analysis Division, concerning the above-captioned proceeding.

Applicants described the operation of the program access rules and the impact of the program access arbitration provision adopted in the *Adelphia Order*. Applicants discussed the program carriage rules and stated their view that there is no justification in the record for the adoption of carriage conditions in this proceeding. Applicants also explained that there is no need to impose conditions related to online distribution of video programming in this proceeding, especially given the nascent and dynamic state of online video distribution and the record evidence demonstrating that Applicants will have no ability or incentive to harm that business post-transaction. Finally, Applicants discussed the public interest benefits that will result from the proposed transaction and the voluntary

commitments they have made in connection with the transaction. Applicants' remarks were consistent with written pleadings that Applicants have previously filed in proceeding.
