In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, we hereby provide you with notice of an oral ex parte presentation in connection with the above-captioned proceeding. On October 28, 2010, undersigned counsel, on behalf of Smith Bagley, Inc. ("SBI"), met with Brad Gillen, Margaret McCarthy, Bill Huber, Stephen Johnson, Margaret Wiener, Jane Jackson, Geoffrey Blackwell, Cynthia Bryant, Irene Flannery, Alexander Minard, Dan Rumelt, Trent Harkrader, Vickie Robinson, Amy Bender, Rebecca Goodheart, Zachary Katz, Sharon Gillett, Carol Matthey, Patrick Halley, and Michael Steffen.

We discussed SBI's experience serving tribal lands, including its use of high-cost and low income support to improve telecommunications services to rural citizens living on Navajo, Hopi, White Mountain Apache, Ramah Navajo and Zuni lands. SBI asked the Commission to establish a Lifeline for Broadband program as part of implementing the National Broadband Plan. SBI also discussed three pending proceedings which it is a party, (1) its request for the Commission to provide uncapped support on the Eastern Navajo Agency (05-337), (2) its request for a ruling reversing a decision by USAC to cap Interstate Access Support on tribal lands (08-71 and 05-337), and (3) its petition for rulemaking to increase Tier 4 Lifeline support by \$5.00 (RM-11529). We reiterated the positions SBI has taken in the record of these proceedings.
