REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION

1. The Chief, Enforcement Bureau (“Bureau”), by her attorney, hereby requests clarification of Order, FCC 10M-11 (ALJ, rel. Oct. 22, 2010) (“Order”). The Order requires the parties to file their respective status reports on October 28, 2010, and otherwise suspends all procedural dates until further order of the Presiding Judge. However, footnote 1 of the Order, the subject of this request for clarification, requires the Bureau to file its Trial Brief on or before October 29, 2010.

2. On October 21, 2010, at the *same time* that the Bureau received an advance copy of the referenced Order, it filed a Request For Extension of Time. In its Request for Extension of Time, the Bureau explained, among other things, that it is still actively engaged in discovery. Consequently, the Bureau requested that the deadline for submitting its Trial Brief (to the extent the Presiding Judge construes the Trial Brief to constitute the Bureau’s Direct Case Exhibits) be deferred until approximately one month prior to commencement of the hearing in this proceeding.

Given that the Bureau requested deferral of the filing of its Trial Brief at essentially the same time that the Presiding Judge was establishing a new deadline for its submission, it is unclear to the Bureau whether the October 29, 2010, deadline in footnote 1 of the Order remains operative. The Bureau respectfully requests the Presiding Judge clarify that it is relieved of filing a Trial Brief until such time that the Presiding Judge rules on the pending Request for Extension of Time referenced above. Alternatively, if the Presiding Judge orders the Bureau to submit its Trial Brief on October 29, 2010, the Bureau requests the clarification it sought in its October 21, 2010 pleading.


