This is to notify you that on November 1, 2010, Jim Morgan of Sony, Megan Stull of Google, John Bergmayer of Public Knowledge, Adam Goldberg of AGP, LLP, Bob Schwartz of Constantine Cannon (and counsel to CEA and CERC) and the undersigned, met with William Lake, Chief of the Media Bureau, and Steve Broeckaert, Michelle Carey, Lyle Elder, Kris Anne Monteith, Brendan Murray, Mary Beth Murphy, Nancy Murphy, Alison Neplokh, Jeff Neumann, and Samuel Drezdson.

At the meeting, we expressed the parties' continued support for adopting an "AllVid" regime, as proposed in the *Notice of Inquiry* in the above-captioned proceeding. We urged the Commission to issue a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking expeditiously so that consumers may soon realize the benefits of a competitive marketplace for video devices.
