Zone Telecom, Inc. and Zone USA, Inc.. (“Applicants”), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), hereby supplement Applicants’ transfer of control applications dated October 13, 2010 and October 14, 2010 (“Applications”) with the following information, as requested by FCC staff.

Associated Network Partners, Inc. (“ANPI”), a party to the Applications, is currently affiliated with Common Point, LLC (“Common Point”), an Illinois limited liability company. ANPI holds a 25% direct ownership interest in Common Point. Common Point is an interexchange access tandem, which provides only interexchange access services to other carriers. Common Point provides services in Illinois, Missouri, Wisconsin and Washington. No other parties to the Applications are currently affiliated with any other domestic telecommunications carriers.
