Pursuant to Section 1.1200, et seq., of the Commission's Rules, National Public Radio, Inc. ("NPR") hereby notifies the Commission of the following *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding.

On Tuesday, November 2, 2010, Rishi Hingoraney, NPR Director of Public Policy and Legislation, and the undersigned met with Joshua Cinelli, Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps. The parties discussed the pending FM translator applications filed during the 2003 filing window, the proposals recently submitted by the Educational Media Foundation and the Prometheus Radio Project, and NPR's previously submitted responses to those proposals. NPR emphasized the important public service its members' FM translator stations provide and pointed out that the service of LPFM stations is not inherently superior to that of FM translator stations and that most of the 2003 FM translator applicants, including the NPR member applicants, filed applications with the intention of serving the public rather than trafficking in construction permits. The parties also discussed opportunities to increase the amount of spectrum available for both LPFM and FM translator stations.
