Ms. Dortch,

I am from Utah and am employed in the Utah Television Translator System. In this system we use both the 6887.5 – 7112.5 and 12712.5 – 13237.5 microwave bands for our “Back-Bone”. Our modulation scheme requires 25 MHz wide channels.

The translator system in Utah is funded by the taxpayers, and overseen and licensed by the various Counties. The cost to change this system would be far above the budgets that are now available for this system. It would be unfair to expect a Public Service to pay for the cost of re-coordination or changes of any kind.

We therefore appose any changes that would affect our system.
