Over a fifty year period, the State of Utah has planned for and developed a very complex TV Translator network to serve rural residents of Utah living beyond the Wasatch front. They have accomplished this with the support of local county governments, Utah State Government, our Federal Government and the Federal Communications Commission. The 6887.5 to 7112.5 and the 12712.5 to 13237.5 microwave bands serve as the "Backbone" infrastructure to this unique DTV translator network.

As a Field Engineer in this TV translator network, I strongly oppose any re-structuring of channels within these bands that would disrupt this much needed subscription free service to the rural parts of this state.
