Pursuant to Section 1.1200, et seq., of the Commission's Rules, National Public Radio, Inc. ("NPR") hereby notifies the Commission of the following *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding.

On Monday, November 8, 2010, Mike Riksen, NPR Vice President for Policy and Representation, Rishi Hingoraney, NPR Director of Public Policy and Legislation, Mike Starling, NPR Chief Technology Officer and Executive Director of NPR Labs, and the undersigned met with Barbara Kreisman, Peter Doyle, Eloise Gore, Susan Crawford, and Rebecca Hanson, all of the Media Bureau, and Michele Ellison, Eric Bash, and Priya Shrinivasan, all of the Enforcement Bureau. The parties discussed the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above-referenced proceeding specifically with respect to LPTV stations operating on analog television channel 6. NPR urged Commission action clarifying that LPTV channel 6 stations operating as ersatz radio stations are not operating in compliance with the Commission's Rules.
