Dear Mr. Havens,

SCRRA is in receipt of your October 19, 2010 request for public records following up on your earlier April 23, 2010 request for records regarding the "SCRRA-MCLM contract for 217-222MHz FCC radio frequency licenses." In an effort to clarify and be as helpful as possible we have organized your request into 6 categories. Please let us know if we have not understood your request accurately. In accordance with the California Public Records Act, we respond to your requests as follows:

Request No. 1

For the time period April 23, 2010--October 28, 2010, "All written contracts, agreements, understandings and undertakings, including all drafts, signed or authorized by any person representing SCRRA, between SCRRA and a company called Maritime Communications/ Land Mobile LLC --(sometimes also called "MCLM", or any company with a similar name, or any agent of said company: herein together called "MCLM")-- to obtain use of or title to any FCC-licensed radio spectrum in the 217 to 222 MHz range."

Request No. 2


For the time period between April 23, 2010--October 28, 2010, "All correspondence and communications of any kind that relate to item '1' above between SCRRA and MCLM."

the Federal Communications Commission (the "FCC"), (ii) any other federal agency including the Federal Railroad Administration, or (iii) any State of California agency, employee of any State of California agency, or member of the State of California legislature."

Request No. 4


"All of the technical and operational assessments and other due diligence conducted by or for SCRAA on said potential spectrum use."

Request No. 5

"All documents with communications relating to said potential that SCRAA holds or controls that are to or from any other US railroad agency or private railroad company, including any that may have financial or other current or potential relations with SCRAA



of any kind, including said potential spectrum use of any 217-222 MHz."

Response to Request No 5

SCRRA is searching for, and will collect and appropriately examine what may be a voluminous amount of records. Response to Request No 6


