

On October 26, 2010, the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") filed Request for Clarification of *Order* FCC 10M-11, released October 22, 2010, requiring the Bureau to file its Trial Brief on October 29. On October 21, 2010, the Bureau had filed Request for Extensions of Time seeking, *inter alia*, leave to file its Trial Brief four weeks before commencement of hearing, a date which has yet to be set. The Presiding Judge was unaware of the Bureau's extension request when he issued the aforesaid *Order*.

For good cause stated, the Enforcement Bureau's Motion for Extensions of time is granted *in part*; the Bureau may defer the filing of its Trial Brief to a time after October 29, 2010, *sine die*; and Mr. Crowell may supplement his current Trial Brief simultaneously with a date to be set for the Bureau's Trial Brief.<sup>1</sup>
