

Just a Reminder About MCI's Adult Policies...

MCI will not bill and collect for 900 numbers associated with adult entertainment services. MCI has four NXXs, 435, 725, 745 and 993 exclusively reserved for adult applications and will only provide transport service for those numbers.

Exhibit C of the Billing and Collections Contract states MCI will not provide billing and collection services for programs that are inconsistent with our program content guidelines:

"Any program which in MCI's sole discretion is thought to be adult programming whether recorded or live. 'Adult' programming is defined as programming or advertising which explicitly or implicitly offers or is intended to offer sexual stimulation or arousal. MCI will deem as 'adult' any program that is advertised in any adult medium, even if the advertising or preamble indicates that the program content is not adult in nature and the content, in fact, is not adult."

MCI has a monitoring group that performs test calls on randomly selected numbers. MCI also responds to complaints on 900 numbers. These complaints are received from both internal and external groups (i.e. Systems Integrity, FCC, LECs, Attorneys General, concerned callers, etc.). Each number is investigated and, if found to be adult in nature, MCI will work with the customer and Account Team to bring the program into compliance or transfer the program to the appropriate NXX.

Repeated violations of this policy by a particular customer, will result in an MCI review of the appropriateness of continued provision of 900 service. MCI appreciates the support of service bureaus and information providers in fully implementing this policy.

MCI Announces New Adult Prefixes, 725 & 993

In response to customer demand, MCI has assigned 725 and 993 as additional prefixes for adult entertainment programs. This brings the total number of adult NXXs to four: 435, 725, 745 and 993.

Since 725 and 993 were previously reserved for non-adult programming, all existing non-adult programs on these prefixes should be transferred to a different NXX by April 1, 1995.

Please contact your MCI Account Team to arrange for transfer of any non-adult programs from these new adult NXXs to any of MCI's other 900 prefixes. Your Account Team can also assist you in reserving numbers for adult applications under the 725 and 993 NXXs if you are interested in offering adult services on a Transport Only basis via these additional exchanges.

How To Reserve an MCI 900 Number

You have two options for selecting a 900 number. The number can be randomly assigned by MCI's Reservation System, or you can choose the number(s) from the available pool of 900 numbers.

be reserved if available. Reservations are completed on a first-come-first-served basis.

When you request a 900 number, your request is entered into MCI's Reservation System. If it is available, you will be notified, and it will remain reserved for a period of 21 days. If the 900 service order has not been placed within the 21-day period, the number again becomes available. MCI may permit you to re-reserve the number if it is available. When your 900 order has been entered into MCI's 900 order system, the 900 number is considered assigned to you so long as it is placed into "substantial" use. When you cancel your MCI 900 Service,

the number is put "on hold." The number is unavailable for reassignment for one hundred and eighty (180) days. After 180 days, the 900 number is cancelled and again becomes available for reservation.
