Hello Radha,

USAC is in receipt of 2004-2009 FCC Forms 499-A and 499-Q received on September 9, 2010.

We have accepted and will process the 2004-2009 FCC Forms 499-A but have rejected the 2004-2009 FCC Forms 499-Q. This is due to the fact that the actual revenue reported on the annual forms trumps the projected revenue reported on the quarterly forms and thus only data from the annual forms is required for these years that are past and have an associated FCC Form 499-A.

However, on the 2005-2009 FCC Forms 499-A you have reported 100% intrastate private line revenue on line 406. As discussed in our conversation yesterday please verify that this revenue is in fact 100% intrastate remembering the following from page 21 of the [FCC Form 499-A Instructions](#):

If over ten percent of the traffic carried over a private or WATS line is interstate, then the revenues and costs generated by the entire line are classified as interstate.³⁴

If you determine that the revenue should be reported as interstate, please file revisions to the 2005-2009 FCC Forms 499-A to correct this.
