On November 12, 2010 James Talbot and I met with James Ball, George Li and Troy Tanner of the Commission's International Bureau to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. Kimberly Cook of the International Bureau participated via teleconference.

During the meeting we explained that AT&T's circuits on this route remain unconnected and we provided an update on discussions between AT&T and the terminating service providers in Tonga. We also stressed AT&T's support for the enforcement of the \$0.19 benchmark rate on U.S.-Tonga calls routed via third countries.
