

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206 of the FCC's rules, that yesterday, George L. Mahoney, Vice President, Secretary, and General Counsel of Media General, Inc. ("Media General"), and I met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff in Chairman Julius Genachowski's Office, and Marilyn Sonn, Acting Legal Advisor on Media, Enforcement and Consumer Affairs to Chairman Genachowski. In the meeting, Mr. Mahoney discussed the positions that Media General has taken over the years in advocating for repeal of the newspaper/broadcast cross-ownership rule. The discussions included Media General's focus on delivering high quality local news and information. Mr. Mahoney also discussed the company's interest in seeing that any spectrum modifications that the FCC may propose in the future do not interfere with its ability to continue to deliver such high quality local programming on a traditional, over-the-air basis and via Mobile Digital Television.
