This is to inform you that on November 17, 2010, the undersigned, representing Wireless Extenders, Inc. ("Wi-Ex"), along with Russell Lukas, counsel to Wilson Electronics, Inc. and Steven Augustino, counsel to Digital Antenna, Inc., met with Bureau Chief Ruth Milkman, Michael McKenzie, Roger Noel, Joyce Jones, and Thomas Derenge, all of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss issues related to the above-captioned proceeding pertaining to the use of signal booster devices used by consumers of commercial wireless services.

We discussed the important customer benefits of signal booster devices, which enable consumers, public safety and other government agencies, and others to receive wireless service in areas and inside buildings with weak to no signal. We expressed our support for a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above-captioned proceeding, and explained the harm to consumers that would stem from a ruling that the use of non-interfering signal boosters without prior wireless carrier consent was prohibited. We also discussed other approaches to ensure that consumers were able to continue using these devices, which meet an important consumer demand and enable consumers to receive wireless signals where they live, work, and play.
