“I am afraid right now we do not have the option of showing captions when the game is on.”

I believe this link is located in Europe, possibly England (I was billed by MB-SALE.COM). At home I do not subscribe to cable because of the high cost as well as the frequency of my wife's and my travels. And I don't like having to go to a Sports Bar when I could watch it at no cost (subscription to this link cost me \$48.86 for 3 years or \$19.00/year) any place I can get Internet connections (ie. motels, hotels, RV Parks, other peoples homes, etc.). While I recognize that I'm getting a very good price for this service, I want the same access that hearing people in this country get for the same price and service via the audio, which I cannot understand.
