On November 23, 2010, Randall Stephenson, Chairman, Chief Executive Officer and President of AT&T Inc., spoke by telephone with Chairman Julius Genachowski regarding the above-referenced proceedings. During their discussion, Mr. Stephenson emphasized that the Commission's broadband policies should encourage investment and innovation in next-generation broadband networks and services. Mr. Stephenson urged the Commission not to adopt regulations that lack sensitivity to the dynamics of investment in a difficult economy, or to the capabilities and challenges inherent in different broadband technologies. Mr. Stephenson also committed to work with Chairman Genachowski to develop consumer-focused, pro-investment policies that will enable the Commission to pursue the goals of the National Broadband Plan.
