On November 19, 2010, CTIA–The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”) met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to Chairman Julius Genachowski, to discuss wireless net neutrality issues. CTIA was represented by Steve Largent, President and CEO, and Chris Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs. Consistent with CTIA’s previous filings in this docket, CTIA argued that net neutrality rules are not needed for mobile wireless broadband and urged the Commission to recognize the differences that make wireless unique when considering the application of net neutrality to broadband.
