In accordance with Section 1.1.206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on November 23, 2010, Luis Coello of IConnect Wholesale, Inc. d/b/a TeleCuba ("TeleCuba"), Thomas J. Navin of Wiley Rein, and I met with Bureau Chief Mindel De La Torre, Deputy Chief Roderick Porter, Assistant Bureau Chief David Strickland, and Policy Division Chief Jim Ball, all of the Federal Communications Commission's International Bureau regarding the Petition for Waiver filed by TeleCuba in the above captioned proceeding.

During the meeting, Mr. Coello provided the attendees with additional background on TeleCuba and his plans for the provision of telecommunications service to Cuba. TeleCuba reiterated the positions already in the record as to why a waiver of the International Settlements Policy to increase the settlement rate for Cuba is necessary and in the public interest. TeleCuba also discussed that the record indicates nothing but support for its petition and that grant of the requested relief is consistent with administration policy favoring increased provision of telecommunications service to Cuba. Finally, TeleCuba requested an update as to the status of its petition.
