Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 24, 2010, Kathy Zachem, Vice President, Regulatory and State Legislative Affairs, Comcast Corporation; Rick Cotton, Executive Vice President and General Counsel, NBC Universal, Inc. (“NBCU”); Ron Stern, Vice President and Senior Competition Counsel, General Electric Company; Arthur Burke, Davis Polk & Wardwell LLP; and the undersigned (collectively, “Applicants”) met via conference call with John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman for Transactions, and Rick Kaplan, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to the Chairman.

Applicants continued discussions on the online issues addressed in a November 23rd ex parte notice.¹ Applicants described the many complexities with any condition that would require the licensing of programming to online video distributors, particularly given the significant differences between traditional MVPD distribution and online video distribution. Applicants re-emphasized the significance of NBCU’s past licensing behavior (as contained in the record) in this regard. Finally, Applicants discussed the difficulties with applying an arbitration process to online distribution.
