Dear Ms. Dortch:

This notice is submitted in compliance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules.

On November 26, 2010, Tyrone Brown of Media Access Project ("MAP") spoke by telephone with the Chairman with respect to the pending open internet proceeding. In the conversation, Mr. Brown expressed support for establishment of a platform for an open Internet. He repeated MAP's opposition to any outcome which treats wireless broadband services differently than wireline services. He argued in favor of strong anti-discrimination provisions, and for effective enforcement mechanisms based on specific regulations, not a case-by-case complaint process. With respect to the Commission's authority, Mr. Brown emphasized that assertion of strong rulemaking and oversight powers will enable the Commission to act in future, as yet unforeseen, circumstances.
