On November 24, Richard Engelman, Director, Spectrum Resources-Government Affairs for Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”) and the undersigned of Hogan Lovells US LLP, Counsel to Sprint Nextel and Special Counsel to FiberTower Corporation (“FiberTower”) and the Rural Telecommunications Group (“RTG”), spoke by teleconference with Brett Tarnutzer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“Bureau”). During the brief teleconference, the representatives discussed their proposal to permit limited fixed licensed use of the vacant TV Bands White Spaces in Channels 14-20 in rural and tribal areas to provide more cost-effective backhaul options, as detailed by their prior filings in this proceeding. The representatives also briefly discussed the Bureau’s planned repacking analysis of the broadcast television spectrum.
