Dear Ms. Dortch / Ms. Majcher:

On October 27, 2010, the Iowa Utilities Board (Board) issued an order amending the eligible telecommunications carrier designation for Southeast Wireless, Inc. On November 2, 2010, the Board issued orders amending the eligible telecommunications carrier designation for Cooperative Telephone Company, Wellman Cooperative Telephone Association, and Wapsi Wireless, LLC. On November 4, 2010, the Board issued orders amending the eligible telecommunications carrier designation for Community Digital Wireless, Sharon Telephone Company, and Cedar County PCS. With this letter, the Board hereby certifies that all federal high cost support provided to the aforementioned Competitive ETCs in this state will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, consistent with section 254(e) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. This includes High Cost Loop support (HCL), Local Switching Support (LSS), and high cost support received pursuant to the purchase of exchanges. The Board bases this certification on the individual carrier certifications filed by the aforementioned Competitive ETCs.



**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO AMEND
ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER DESIGNATION**

(Issued October 27, 2010)

On August 27, 2010, Southeast Wireless, Inc. (Southeast), filed a request with the Utilities Board (Board) to amend a Board order issued April 26, 2002, pursuant to 199 IAC 39.2, granting eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) designation to Southeast. Southeast seeks an amendment to the Board's April 26, 2002, order to allow it to add additional wire centers, identified in Exhibits B and C that are attached to this order, to the designated service area established for Southeast in the 2002 order.

In support of its motion, Southeast states that since the Board approved its ETC designation, it has continued to build out its licensed service area, approved by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), to include these additional wire centers. Southeast asserts that there will be no change made to the study areas comprising the designated service area and that granting this motion will merely enable it to receive federal universal service support for each eligible subscriber served within the designated service area.

Southeast states that it has filed timely compliance statements and service quality reports pursuant to the requirements of 199 IAC 39.2 and commits that the federal universal service support it receives will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of the facilities and services for which the support is intended, consistent with 47 U.S.C. § 254(e). Southeast also commits that it will comply with applicable Iowa statutes, rules, and regulations applicable to all competitive ETCs.

The Board has reviewed Southeast's request and finds that it is reasonable. In 2002, Southeast met all the requirements of the Board's rules and was designated as an ETC in Iowa. It has acquired an additional designated service area. In the request filed on August 27, 2010, Southeast made the necessary certifications so as to substantially comply with 199 IAC 39.2, including voice grade access to the public switched network, local usage, call setup technology, single-party service, and access to emergency services, operator services, interexchange service, and directory assistance. Toll limitation for low-income customers (199 IAC 39.2(1)"j") is not relevant for a wireless carrier that does not charge separately for toll calls. Furthermore, the relief sought in Southeast's request is analogous to the relief the Board has granted to U.S. Cellular Corp., by order issued March 30, 2007, and NPCR, Inc., d/b/a Nextel Partners, by order issued December 17, 2007. For these reasons, the Board will amend Southeast's ETC designation to add the additional

wire centers, identified in the exhibits attached to this order, to its designated service area.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The request to amend its designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier filed by Southeast Wireless, Inc., on August 27, 2010, is granted as described in this order.

2. The designated service area for Southeast Wireless, Inc., shall be amended so as to add the additional wire centers identified in Exhibits B and C that are attached to this order.

3. The Executive Secretary of the Utilities Board shall mail copies of this order to Southeast Wireless, Inc.; the Universal Service Administration Company; the Federal Communications Commission Universal Service Branch; and the Federal Communications Commission Office of the Secretary.





**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO AMEND
ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER DESIGNATION**

(Issued November 2, 2010)

On August 27, 2010, Cooperative Telephone Company (Cooperative) filed a request with the Utilities Board (Board) to amend a Board order issued April 26, 2002, pursuant to 199 IAC 39.2, granting eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) designation to Cooperative. Cooperative filed a correction to the application on October 25, 2010. Cooperative seeks an amendment to the Board's April 26, 2002, order to allow it to add additional wire centers, identified in Exhibits B and C that are attached to this order, to the designated service area established for Cooperative in the 2002 order.

In support of its motion, Cooperative states that since the Board approved its ETC designation, it has continued to build out its licensed service area, approved by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), to include these additional wire centers. Cooperative asserts that there will be no change made to the study areas comprising the designated service area and that granting this motion will merely enable it to receive federal universal service support for each eligible subscriber served within the designated service area.

Cooperative states that it has filed timely compliance statements and service quality reports pursuant to the requirements of 199 IAC 39.2 and commits that the federal universal service support it receives will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of the facilities and services for which the support is intended, consistent with 47 U.S.C. § 254(e). Cooperative also commits that it will comply with applicable Iowa statutes, rules, and regulations applicable to all competitive ETCs.

The Board has reviewed Cooperative's request, as corrected, and finds that it is reasonable. In 2002, Cooperative met all the requirements of the Board's rules and was designated as an ETC in Iowa. It has acquired an additional designated service area. In the request filed on August 27, 2010, Cooperative made the necessary certifications so as to substantially comply with 199 IAC 39.2, including voice grade access to the public switched network, local usage, call setup technology, single-party service, and access to emergency services, operator services, interexchange service, and directory assistance. Toll limitation for low-income customers (199 IAC 39.2(1)"j") is not relevant for a wireless carrier that does not charge separately for toll calls. Furthermore, the relief sought in Cooperative's request is analogous to the relief the Board has granted to Southeast Wireless, Inc., by order issued October 27, 2010, to U.S. Cellular Corp. by order issued March 30, 2007, and to NPCR, Inc., d/b/a Nextel Partners, by order issued December 17, 2007. For these reasons, the Board will amend Cooperative's ETC designation to add the

additional wire centers, identified in the exhibits attached to this order, to its designated service area.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The request to amend its designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier filed by Cooperative Telephone Company on August 27, 2010, and corrected on October 25, 2010, is granted as described in this order.

2. The designated service area for Cooperative Telephone Company shall be amended so as to add the additional wire centers identified in Exhibits B and C that are attached to this order.

3. The Executive Secretary of the Utilities Board shall send copies of this order to Cooperative Telephone Company; the Universal Service Administration Company; the Federal Communications Commission, Universal Service Branch; and the Federal Communications Commission, Office of the Secretary.



AREA REFERENCE MAP


