On December 6, 2010, the undersigned of this Firm, on behalf of News Corporation, spoke by telephone with Dave Grimaldi and Angela Kronenberg of Commissioner Clyburn's office in connection with the above-referenced proceedings.

During the call, I reiterated arguments made in comments, reply comments and ex parte letters submitted as part of these proceedings by the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc., of which Twentieth Century Fox Film Corp., a News Corporation company, is a member. In particular, I emphasized the need for copyright owners and Internet service providers to work together to combat online copyright theft and I stressed that any Commission rules adopted as part of these proceedings should not prevent Internet service providers from taking prompt action against copyright infringers.
