On December 8, 2010, Christopher Guttman-McCabe and Brian Josef, CTIA - The Wireless Association®, along with Joseph Marx, AT&T, Richard Engelman, Sprint Nextel, Chris Wiczorek, T-Mobile, and Andy Lachance and Tamara Preiss, Verizon Wireless, met with Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor for Commissioner Mignon Clyburn. The above-listed parties discussed the ongoing proceeding regarding the use of signal boosters and other signal amplification techniques for wireless services.

During the meeting, the parties highlighted the increasing incidents of harmful interference to commercial and Public Safety wireless networks caused by the unauthorized operation of signal boosters. The parties reiterated their support for FCC action affirming and enforcing the requirement in its rules that a FCC license, or express licensee consent, is necessary to operate a signal booster. They also raised important considerations to be addressed when evaluating technical and operational features for boosters.
