Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, DISH Network L.L.C. ("DISH") submits this letter summarizing a telephone call on Thursday, December 9, 2010, between Jeffrey Blum, Senior Vice President and Deputy General Counsel of DISH, and Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff for Chairman Genachowski.

During the telephone call, DISH expressed its support for strong Open Internet rules, and suggested certain improvements to the proposed rules reported to be under consideration for adoption at the upcoming Commission Open Meeting, including (1) more robust wireless broadband protections, (2) a broader definition of broadband Internet access service that would limit the carriers' ability to evade the rules, and (3) making clear that paid priority on the best efforts Internet is presumptively improper.
