I am appealing the determination that FRN 1812358 is approved for telecom service and must maintain a telecom eligible spin number. Your new selected spin, 143033538, is not telecom eligible (it is Non Compliant) and cannot be used for this spin change. Please review this information with your provider and resubmit with a telecom eligible spin.

Rationale:

The establishing 470 was #692840000630320. The establishing 470 becomes the basis for determining the category of services. The service for FRN 1812358 was posted both under telecommunications and internet access. Between the time the 471 was filed using an eligible teleco Cue Connex SPIN 143032191 and after receiving the

FCDL the original service provider went out of business. The contract was assigned to the new service provider First Security Leasing SPIN 14303353. The school corporation should be held harmless for this act and allowed the Operational SPIN change since they did not have the opportunity to select a new service provider.

I have contacted First Security Leasing and they are not interested in becoming an eligible teleco.
