This ex parte covers two recent communications with Commissioner Clyburn and her office. On Wednesday December 8, 2010, IATSE (International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees) Washington DC Representative, Alec French and DGA (Directors Guild of America), spoke with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn over the telephone. Discussions in his conversation were consistent with the issues of content protection on the Internet and its impact on the members of DGA and IATSE that we have expressed in seven filings with the FCC over the past two years and in recent discussions held by the MPAA (Motion Pictures Association of America, Inc.) with the Commission.

On December 10, 2010, AFTRA (American Federation of Television and Radio Artists), DGA, IATSE, and SAG (Screen Actors Guild) sent a letter via email to commissioner Clyburn concerning the Open Internet Order on the Agenda for the FCC Meeting on December 21, 2010. That letter was provided to you by the DGA along with its December 10th correspondence. We raise similar issues that urge the commission to ensure that the existing and long-held creative and economic rights of the 300,000 members of the above guilds and unions are protected.
