On Monday, December 13, 2010, Linda Kinney of the Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA) had a telephone conversation with Rosemary Harold of Commissioner McDowell's office. The discussion focused on the need for copyright owners and Internet service providers to work together to combat online copyright theft.

MPAA, the Directors Guild of America (DGA), the International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE), and the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) urge the Commission to clarify that cooperative efforts by broadband Internet access service providers and other service providers, which are designed to curtail infringement in response to information provided by rights holders in a manner that is timely, effective, and accommodates the legitimate interests of providers, copyright owners and users, are fully consistent with and should be encouraged by the Commission's open Internet rules.
