This is to inform you that on December 14, 2010, Walter McCormick, CEO of USTelecom, spoke by telephone with Commissioner Michael Copps in connection with the proceedings identified above.

During this meeting, USTelecom emphasized the continuing absence of a problem for which the proposed Internet regulations are supposedly intended to address. Indeed, the Commission's own recently released studies demonstrate that the vast majority of consumers satisfied with their Internet experience and do not perceive any impediment to switching to another provider if they chose to do so.
