Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 13, 2010, CTIA–The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”) met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, along with Dave Grimaldi, Chief of Staff, Angie Kronenberg, Legal Advisor, and Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor, to discuss wireless net neutrality issues. CTIA was represented by Steve Largent, President and CEO, Chris Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, and Scott Bergmann, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs.

Consistent with CTIA’s previous filings in this docket, CTIA argued that net neutrality rules are not needed for mobile wireless broadband and urged the Commission to recognize the differences that make wireless unique when considering the application of net neutrality to broadband. CTIA also shared a brief video produced by Mobile Future, which demonstrates key consumer and technology mobile trends. The Mobile Future video is available at:

In addition, CTIA distributed the attached one-page snapshot illustrating the evolution that has taken place in the mobile wireless ecosystem over the last three years. From the number of smartphones being adopted by consumers to the number of companies designing wireless devices for the U.S. market and applications for those devices, the wireless broadband ecosystem has exploded and consumers have benefitted in the absence of regulation.
