On January 6, 2011, the undersigned met with Joshua Cinelli, Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps, regarding the above-captioned proceeding. I provided a general overview of Applicants' positions on issues that have been raised in the proceeding. I addressed the arguments advanced by the American Cable Association relating to small cable operators and Applicants' previously-filed responses thereto. I reviewed the various commitments Applicants have made on the record, and emphasized the many public interest benefits that will result from approval of the proposed transaction. In particular, I explained Applicants' commitment to add ten new independent networks over the next eight years, Applicants' proposals regarding broadband deployment and adoption, and Applicants' commitment to increase local news. Finally, I urged the Commission's prompt review and approval of the transaction. All of my comments were consistent with Applicants' prior written submissions in the proceeding.
